Step 1: Log Into Avast Account

Common Problems + Clear Solutions


 “I can’t find my Avast  [+1]888-754-6002 subscription”

Cause: Wrong email account

✓ **Fix:** Try all email IDs used

 “There’s no cancel button”

Cause: Subscription managed externally

✓ **Fix:** Cancel via  [+1]888-754-6002 Apple, Google, or reseller

 “I uninstalled Avast but still charged”

Reality: Uninstall ≠ cancel

✓ **Fix:** Disable auto-renew manually

 “Still billed  [+1]888-754-6002 after cancelling”

Cause: Cancellation after renewal date

✓ **Fix:** Contact support for refund

Refund Policy: What You Should Know



Avast usually offers a 📞 [+1]888-754-6002 **30-day money-back guarantee**:

✓ Eligible if:

- You cancel within 30 days of purchase or renewal
 - You haven't heavily used the service
-

📞 [+1]888-754-6002 ! Important:

- Refunds depend on timing
- Third-party purchases follow separate rules

👉 Always cancel BEFORE renewal date
