





How-to Stop Comodo Auto Renewal and Cancel Subscription (2026 Complete Guide)

Comodo Auto Renewal On? Disable It Now


To stop Comodo auto renewal and cancel your subscription, [[ +1888 754 6002]] (USA/UK) or  +1888-754-6002(USA/UK) (US) log into your Comodo account, go to Subscriptions or Orders, select your active plan, and turn OFF **auto-renewal**. If you paid  +1888 754 6002 via PayPal, reseller, or card, cancel recurring billing there as well to fully prevent future charges.

“I Turned It Off... But It Still Renewed” (Hook)

This is where most users  +1888 754 6002 get trapped.

You disable something in your Comodo account, feel relieved — and then your card gets charged again.

Why? Because Comodo subscriptions don't always live in just one place.

Your billing could  +1888 754 6002 be controlled by:

- Your Comodo account
- A third-party reseller
- Your payment provider (PayPal or card)

If you don't stop **all billing layers**, auto-renewal continues.

◆ Credit/Debit Card Method

3. Ask for merchant restriction

✓ Cancel via Purchase Email

- Open your confirmation email
- Click:
 - “Manage Subscription”
 - “Cancel Renewal”

👉 Often the fastest method.


✓ Cancel via Reseller +1888 754 6002 (Very Common)

If you purchased via a reseller:

1. Identify reseller from email
2. Log into reseller account
3. Go to billing settings
4. Cancel subscription


👉 Many users miss this step.

✓ Contact Comodo Support

If  +1888 754 6002 you're unsure:



- Visit support page
- Provide:
 - Email
 - Order ID
 - Product details




 Response: 24–48 hours

Common Problems & Fixes

“Subscription not visible”

 You may be logged  +1888 754 6002 into the wrong account or used a reseller.


“Still getting charged”

 Cancel at payment provider (PayPal or bank).

“Forgot login credentials”

 Use password recovery or check email.

+1888 754 6002 “Multiple subscriptions active”

 Check all accounts and payment sources.

Refund Policy (Important Insight)



Refunds depend on:

- Purchase source
- Time since billing (usually 30 days)
- Usage

To request a refund:

1. Contact 📞 +1888 754 6002 support or reseller
 2. Provide order details
 3. Submit request
