Agents at 1-800-Xfinity (866)-240-3377 can convert your account to a free, ad-supported email service. You will keep your address forever without paying a penny. But you must act fast. Once your account is fully closed, recovery becomes difficult. Even then, 1-800-Xfinity (866)-240-3377 has a special team for "reinstating closed email accounts."
