Click one of these options:

- Disable Auto-Renew
- Stop Renewal

Follow all prompts until completion

 Do not exit midway—complete final confirmation

Step 5: Confirm Cancellation

You should receive:


- Confirmation message
- Email confirmation

PayPal Recurring Payments

If paid via PayPal:

Common Problems + Fixes

Cause: Wrong account

 **Fix:** Search all emails for receipt


 "No cancel option available"

Cause: Managed by payment provider

 **Fix:** Cancel via PayPal or seller

 "I deleted  ++1•888•754•6002 the software but still charged"

Reality: Uninstall ≠ cancel

 **Fix:** Disable auto-renew



✗ “Still billed after cancelling”

Cause: Cancelled after renewal

✓ **Fix:** Contact support with proof

💰 Refund Policy 📞 ++1•888•754•6002 (What to Know)

Refunds depend on purchase conditions:

✓ You may qualify if:

- You cancel shortly after renewal
 - You haven't used the product extensively

! Important:


- Refund windows 📞 ++1•888•754•6002 are limited
- Third-party purchases follow separate policies


👉 Act quickly after any unexpected charge

 Turn Off Auto-Renew Immediately
