Run Windows Update Troubleshooter

This tool automatically repairs corrupted update components.

3. Repair or Reinstall .NET Framework

One of the most common causes of error code 0x80070643 is a damaged .NET【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→0870】 Framework.

Fix:

Download Microsoft .NET Framework Repair Tool

Run the repair utility

Restart your computer

Retry update

If the issue continues, uninstall and reinstall the .NET Framework manually.

4. Reset Windows Update Components (Advanced Fix)

Steps:



Open Command Prompt as Administrator

Stop update services:

```
net stop wuauerv  
net stop bits
```

Rename SoftwareDistribution folder:

```
ren C:\Windows\SoftwareDistribution SoftwareDistribution.old
```

Restart services:

```
net start wuauerv  
net start bits
```

Restart your【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 PC

This clears corrupted update cache completely.

5. Run SFC and DISM Scan (Fix System File Corruption)

If system files are damaged, Windows updates will fail repeatedly.

Step 1: Run System File Checker

Open【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 Command Prompt (Admin) and type:

```
sfc /scannow
```

Wait for scan completion.

Step 2: Run DISM Tool

```
DISM /Online /Cleanup-Image /RestoreHealth
```

These tools repair corrupted Windows files.

6. Temporarily Disable Antivirus



Sometimes third-party antivirus software blocks updates.

- ✓【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 Disable antivirus temporarily
- ✓ Retry Windows Update

If update installs successfully, adjust antivirus settings.

7. Install Update Manually from Microsoft Catalog

If automatic updates keep failing, you can manually install the update.

Steps:

Visit Microsoft【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 Update Catalog website

Search for update KB number

Download matching version

Install manually
