If you've recently changed your router, 1-855-285-0870 updated your internet service, or switched to a different wireless network, your Brother printer may suddenly go offline. Don't worry —  1-(855)-285-0870 this is a common issue. In this complete guide, you'll learn how to connect Brother Printer to new WiFi quickly and correctly, even if you're not tech-savvy.

Why You Need to Reconnect Brother Printer  1-(855)-285-0870 to New WiFi

When you change your router, reset network settings, or update your WiFi password, your Brother printer does not automatically connect to the new network. The printer 



1 → (855) → 285 → O870 ] still stores old network credentials.

Common situations include:

You changed [ ★ 1 → 855 → 285 → O870 ] your WiFi name (SSID)

You updated your WiFi password

You installed a new router

You moved to a new home or [ ☀ 1 → (855) → 285 → O870 ] office

Your printer shows “Offline” or “Cannot Connect”

To resolve this, you must change WiFi on Brother Printer manually.

Quick Overview: Ways to Connect Brother Printer to New WiFi

There are three [ ☀ 1 → (855) → 285 → O870 ] main methods:

Using Printer Control Panel (Recommended)

Using WPS Button (Fast Method)

Using Brother Setup Software (Computer Method)

Let's go through each method in detail.

Method 1: How to Connect Brother Printer [ [ [ ++ 1 → 855 → 285 → O870 ] ] ] to New WiFi from Control Panel

This is the most reliable way.

Step 1: Reset Network Settings (Optional but Recommended)

If you're unsure about old settings:

Turn on your Brother printer.

Press [ ☀ 1 → (855) → 285 → O870 ] Menu.



Go to Network.

Select Network Reset.

Confirm and restart the printer.

This clears old WiFi data.

## Step 2: Connect Brother Printer to New WiFi Network

Press Menu on printer.

Select Network.

Choose WLAN.

Tap Setup Wizard.

Select【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 Yes to enable WLAN.

The printer will search for available networks.

Choose your new WiFi name (SSID).

Enter your new WiFi [★ 1 →855→285→O87O] password.

Press OK.

You should see “Connected” on the screen.

Now【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 your printer is successfully connected to the new wireless network.

## Method 2: How to Reconnect My Brother Printer to WiFi Using WPS

If your router supports WPS (WiFi Protected Setup),【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 this is quicker.

Steps:



Press the WPS button on your router.

Within 2 minutes, go to printer:

Menu → Network → WLAN → WPS

Press OK.

The printer will automatically connect.

⚠ Note: This only【☀ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 works if WPS is enabled on your router.

Method 3: [★ 1→855→285→O87O] How to Change WiFi Network on Brother Printer Using Computer

If the printer doesn't have a display screen,【☀ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 use this method.

Step 1: Download Brother Setup Tool

Go to Brother's official support website.

Download the Full Driver & Software Package for your printer model.

Step 2: Run Wireless Setup

Open the【☀ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 setup file.

Choose Wireless Network Connection.

Select your new WiFi network.

Enter the password.

Follow on-screen instructions.

After completion, your printer will connect to the new network.

How to Reconnect Brother Printer to WiFi【☀ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 [★ 1→855→285→O87O] After Router Change



If you recently installed a new router:

Make sure your printer is within WiFi range.

Confirm your router is broadcasting 2.4GHz (some Brother printers don't support【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 5GHz).

Restart router and printer.

Run Setup Wizard again.

If the printer still shows offline, reinstall printer drivers on your computer.

Fix: Brother Printer Not Connecting to New WiFi

If you tried everything【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 and it's not working, check these:

1. Wrong Password

Double-check case-sensitive WiFi password.

2. 5GHz Network Issue

Older Brother printers support only 2.4GHz.

Log [★ 1 →855→285→O87O] into router settings and enable 2.4GHz band.

3.【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 Printer Too Far from Router

Move printer closer.

4. Firewall Blocking Connection

Temporarily disable firewall during setup.

5. Update Firmware

Visit Brother support and update firmware.

How to Change WiFi on Brother Printer Without【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 Screen



Some compact Brother printers don't have a display.

Here's what to do:

Download Brother iPrint&Scan app.

Connect printer via USB temporarily.

Open app → Select printer → Wireless Setup.

Enter new WiFi details.

Disconnect【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】USB after setup.

How to Connect Brother Printer to New WiFi [★ 1 →855→285→O87O] on Windows 11

After connecting printer to WiFi:

Go to Settings → Bluetooth & Devices → Printers &【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】  
Scanners

Click Add Device

Select your Brother printer

Install drivers if prompted

Now you're ready to print wirelessly.

How to Connect Brother Printer to New WiFi on Mac

Open System Settings

Click Printers & Scanners

Press【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】Add Printer

Select Brother printer from list



Click Add

If printer doesn't appear, install latest Mac drivers from Brother website.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why is my Brother printer not connecting to new WiFi?

Most【☀️ 1 → (855) → 285 → 0870】common [★ 1 → 855 → 285 → 0870] reasons:

Incorrect password

Router using 5GHz only

Printer still connected to old network

Network reset not done

Do I need to reinstall the printer after changing WiFi?

Sometimes yes. Especially if:

Printer【☀️ 1 → (855) → 285 → 0870】shows offline

Computer cannot detect printer

You changed both router and network name

Reinstalling drivers fixes detection problems.

How do I find my Brother printer WiFi password?

Your printer doesn't store visible passwords.

Check【☀️ 1 → (855) → 285 → 0870】your router label or log into router settings to see password.

Can I connect Brother printer without router?

Yes, using WiFi Direct:



Menu [★ 1→855→285→0870] → Network → WLAN → WiFi【☀️ 1→(855)→285→0870】  
Direct

Enable it.

Connect computer directly to printer network.

Pro Tips to Avoid Future WiFi Issues

Keep router and printer within 20–30 feet.

Don't change SSID frequently.

Update printer firmware regularly.

Use strong but simple【☀️ 1→(855)→285→0870】 password.

Avoid connecting printer to guest networks.
