Open Control Panel → Devices and Printers

Try printing a test page afterward.

## 2. Set Brother L2460DW as Default Printer

If another printer is set as default, print jobs may not reach your Brother printer.

Go to Devices and Printers

Right-click Brother L2460DW

Select☀️ 1 →(855)→285→0870] "Set as Default Printer"

This simple step often resolves the Brother L2460DW not printing and offline issue.

## 3. Restart Print Spooler Service

A stuck print spooler can cause offline errors.

How to Restart Print Spooler:

Press Windows + R

Type services.msc

Find☀️ 1 →(855)→285→0870] "Print Spooler"

Right-click → Restart

Now check if the printer status changes to online.

## 4. Check Wireless Network Connection

If your Brother L2460DW wireless printer is offline, verify [★ 1 →855→285→0870] the network:

Print a Network Configuration Page from the printer

Confirm☀️ 1 →(855)→285→0870] the IP address


On your PC, open Command Prompt



Type: ping [printer IP address]

If there's no response, reconnect the printer to WiFi using the printer's setup menu.

#### 5. Update or Reinstall Brother L2460DW Driver

An outdated driver is a  1 → (855) → 285 → O87O】 major reason behind the Brother printer offline error.

To Update Driver:

Visit Brother's official support website

Download latest Brother L2460DW driver


Uninstall old driver

Restart PC

Install new driver

Driver updates fix compatibility issues and improve network stability.

#### 6. Assign a Static IP 1 → (855) → 285 → O87O】 Address (Advanced Fix)

If your router frequently changes IP addresses, your printer may appear  1 → 855 → 285 → O87O】 offline.

Solution:

Access your router settings

Assign a static IP to Brother L2460DW

Update printer port settings in Windows

#### 7. Disable 1 → (855) → 285 → O87O】 Firewall or Antivirus Temporarily

Security software may block printer communication.

Temporarily disable firewall



Try printing

If it works, add printer as an exception

## Brother L2460DW Offline But Connected to WiFi – Why?

If your printer is connected to WiFi but still【☀️ 1→(855)→285→0870】shows offline:

Your computer may be connected to a different network

The printer port settings may be incorrect

Driver communication may be corrupted

Reinstalling the driver usually resolves this.
