Why Won't Brother DCP-T420W Printer Print?

There are several common reasons behind the Brother DCP-T420W not printing issue:

Clogged print head or dried ink

Low or empty ink tank

Printer set to offline mode

Corrupted or  1 →(855)→285→O87O outdated driver

Paper jam


Stuck print queue

Weak WiFi signal

Incorrect default printer settings

Fix 1: Check Ink Levels and Ink Flow

Since the Brother DCP-T420W is an ink tank printer, low ink  1 →(855)→285→O87O or air bubbles in the ink line can stop printing.



What to Do:

Check visible ink levels.


Refill ink tanks if low.

Run Print Head Cleaning from maintenance settings.

Perform a Nozzle Check Test Page.

If your  1 →(855)→285→O87O Brother DCP-T420W not  1 →855→285→O87O printing black, cleaning the print head usually solves it.

Fix 2: Make Sure Printer Is Online

If your Brother DCP-T420W printer connected but not printing, it may be  1 →(855)→285→O87O stuck in offline mode.



On Windows:

Open Control Panel.

Go to Devices and Printers.

Right-click Brother DCP-T420W.

Uncheck Use Printer Offline.

Set it as Default Printer.

This resolves most “printer not responding” errors.

Fix 3: Restart Printer, Router &  1 → (855) → 285 → O87O Computer

Temporary glitches often block print commands.

Steps:

Turn off printer.

Restart your WiFi router.


Restart your computer.

Turn printer back on.

Try printing again.

This simple reset fixes many Brother DCP-T420W wireless printing issues.

Fix 4: Clear Print Queue

A  1 → (855) → 285 → O87O stuck document can stop all printing tasks.

To Clear:

Open Devices and Printers.

Double-click Brother DCP-T420W.

Cancel all pending print jobs.



Restart printer.

Clearing the queue solves [★ 1→855→285→0870] many Brother printer not printing problems instantly.

Fix 5:【☀️ 1→(855)→285→0870】 Update or Reinstall Printer Driver

Outdated drivers are a major cause of printing failure.

How to Fix:

Visit Brother's official support website.

Download latest driver for DCP-T420W.

Install Full Driver & Software Package.

Restart computer.

Driver reinstallation resolves【☀️ 1→(855)→285→0870】 most compatibility errors.

Fix 6: Check WiFi Connection

If you're printing wirelessly:

Ensure printer and computer are on same WiFi network.

Move printer closer to router.

Enable 2.4GHz band (if using dual-band router).

Reconnect printer to WiFi【☀️ 1→(855)→285→0870】 if needed.

Weak signals often cause the Brother DCP-T420W not printing wirelessly issue.

Fix 7: Check for Paper Jam
