If the print spooler stops working, your printer may appear offline.

How to Restart:

Press Windows + R

Type services.msc

Find “Print Spooler”

4. Check WiFi or Network Connection

If your Brother T820DW wireless printer is offline, check:



Printer is connected to correct SSID

WiFi【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 password hasn't changed

Router is functioning properly

You can reconnect the printer to WiFi through the printer's network setup menu.

If needed, print a network configuration page to confirm【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 IP address and connection details.

5. Update or Reinstall Brother T820DW Driver
