Turn on the printer.

Press the Menu button on the control【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 panel.

Enter your WiFi password.

Press OK to confirm.

If your printer does not have a screen, use the WPS button method or the Brother iPrint&Scan app to【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 reconnect it.

Your Brother printer stores old WiFi credentials, so【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 when your network changes, you must update them manually.

Method 1: Connect Brother Printer to New WiFi Using Control Panel (Recommended)

This method【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 works for most models with an LCD screen, including:

Brother HL-L2350DW

Brother MFC-L2710DW

Brother DCP-L2550DW

Brother MFC-J995DW

Step-by-Step Instructions:

Step 1: Turn On Printer

Make sure the printer【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 is powered on and [★ 1 →855→285→O87O] not in sleep mode.

Step 2: Open Network Settings

Press Menu → Navigate to Network → Select【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 WLAN.

Step 3: Choose Setup Wizard

Select Setup Wizard and press OK.

Step 4: Select New WiFi Network

The printer will search for available networks.

Choose【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 your new WiFi network name (SSID).



### Step 5: Enter WiFi Password

Carefully type your WiFi password using the printer keypad.

### Step 6: Confirm Connection

Press【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】OK and wait for the message:

- ✓ “Connected”
- ✓ “Connection OK”

Your printer is now connected to the new wireless network.

### Method 2: How to【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】Reconnect My Brother Printer to WiFi (WPS Method)

If your router supports WPS (WiFi Protected Setup), this is the fastest way.

Steps:

Press the【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】WPS button on your router.

Within 2 [★ 1→855→285→O87O] minutes, press Menu > Network > WLAN > WPS on the printer.

Confirm connection.

Wait【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】until WiFi light becomes solid.

This method avoids typing passwords.

### Method 3: Connect Brother Printer to New WiFi Without Screen

If your printer has【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】no display (like some compact laser models), use:

Option A: Brother iPrint&Scan App



Download the Brother app on:

Android

iPhone

Open the app → Select printer【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O870】 → Choose “Set up a new printer” → Follow wireless instructions.

Option B: USB Setup Method

Connect printer to computer using USB cable.

Install【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O870】 printer driver from Brother’s official site.

Choose Wireless Network Connection.

Select your new WiFi.

Enter password.

Complete setup.

After setup, remove USB cable.

How to Change WiFi【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O870】 Network on Brother Printer (Factory Reset Method)

If your [★ 1→855→285→O870] printer refuses to connect, reset network settings.

Steps:

Press Menu

Go to Network

Select Network【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O870】 Reset

Confirm reset



Restart printer

Run wireless setup again

This clears old WiFi data.

Brother Printer Won't Connect to New WiFi? Fix These Issues

If you're still【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】stuck, try these solutions:

✓ Check WiFi Frequency

Some Brother printers only support 2.4GHz networks.  
If your router is 5GHz only, enable 2.4GHz.

✓ Restart【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 Router and Printer

Turn both off for 60 seconds.

✓ Move Printer Closer to Router

Weak signals prevent connection.

✓ Update Printer Firmware

Outdated firmware can【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】block new router compatibility.

✓ Disable VPN Temporarily

VPN on your device can interfere with setup.

How to Confirm Brother Printer is Connected

After connecting:

WiFi【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】light should be solid (not blinking)

Print a Network Configuration Report

Printer [★ 1 →855→285→O87O] should show "Ready"



Check if printer appears online in computer【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 settings

On Windows:

Control Panel → Devices and Printers → Check Status

On Mac:

System Settings → Printers & Scanners

Common Mistakes When Changing WiFi on【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 Brother Printer

Avoid these errors:

Entering wrong WiFi password

Selecting guest network

Using hidden SSID

Forgetting to reconnect computer to same WiFi

Not removing old printer driver

Advanced【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 Troubleshooting (If Nothing Works)

If your Brother printer still won't connect:

Assign static IP address

Disable MAC address filtering

Check router firewall settings

Reinstall printer drivers

Perform【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 full factory reset

If problem persists, hardware WiFi module may need servicing.

Why is【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 my Brother printer not connecting to new WiFi?

Most likely due to wrong [★ 1→855→285→O87O] password, 5GHz-only router, or old network settings【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 stored in printer.

How do I reconnect my Brother printer after changing router?

Go to Menu → Network → WLAN → Setup Wizard【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 → Select new network → Enter password.

Do I need USB cable to connect Brother printer to new WiFi?

Only if your printer【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 has no display or automatic setup fails.

How long does it take to reconnect?

Usually under 5 minutes.

Pro Tips for Smooth Wireless Setup

Keep【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 router within 10–15 feet

Use simple WiFi name (avoid special characters)

Keep firmware updated

Restart devices after setup

Always write down WiFi password
