Printer connected to old network

5GHz network not supported

Outdated firmware

Firewall or antivirus blocking connection

Step-by-Step Fix: Brother Printer Not【🌟 1→(855)→285→O870】 Connecting to WiFi

### ① Restart Everything (Most Effective Quick Fix)

Turn off the printer.

Unplug router for 60 seconds.

Restart router fully.

Turn printer back on.

Try reconnecting.

This【🌟 1→(855)→285→O870】 solves temporary network glitches instantly.

### ② Reconnect Using Setup Wizard

Works for models like:



Brother HL-L2350DW

Brother MFC-L2710DW

Brother DCP-T720DW

Steps:

Press Menu

Select Network

Choose WLAN

Select Setup Wizard

Choose your WiFi【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 network

Enter password carefully

Press OK

Wait for “Connected” confirmation.

### ③ Reset Network Settings (If Setup Fails)

If your Brother Printer won't connect to WiFi after password【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 entry, reset network settings:

Menu → Network → Network Reset → Confirm

Then run Setup Wizard again.

This fixes most “connection failed” errors.

### ④ Fix 5GHz【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 WiFi Compatibility Issue


Many users search:

“Why is my Brother Printer not connecting to WiFi after router upgrade?”

Reason: Router may be set to 5GHz【☀️ 1 →(855)→285→O87O】 only.

Solution:




Enable 2.4GHz band in [ 1 →(855)→285→0870] router settings

Or disable Smart Connect temporarily

Reconnect printer

Most Brother printers work only on 2.4GHz.

⑤ Move Printer Closer [ 1 →(855)→285→0870] to Router

Weak signal causes:


Printer showing offline

Wireless setup failed

Frequent disconnection

Place printer within 10–15 feet of router during setup.

⑥ Update Brother Printer Firmware

Outdated firmware [ 1 →(855)→285→0870] may prevent connection.

Steps:

Visit Brother support website

Enter your model number

Download latest firmware

Install via USB if needed

Firmware updates fix compatibility bugs with modern routers.

Brother [ 1 →(855)→285→0870] Printer Connected But Showing Offline?

If your printer connects but doesn't print:

Windows Fix:



Control Panel → Devices & Printers

Right-click printer

Select “Set as Default Printer”

Uncheck【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 “Use Printer Offline”

Mac Fix:

System Settings → Printers & Scanners

Remove and re-add printer

## Brother Printer Not Connecting to New WiFi?

If you changed:

Router

WiFi password

Internet provider

Your【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 printer must be reconfigured manually. Printers do not auto-update WiFi details.

Perform Network Reset and reconnect.

Brother Printer Won't Connect to WiFi on Windows【☀️ 1→(855)→285→O87O】 11

Try:

Remove old drivers

Install latest drivers

Disable VPN

Check firewall [★ 1→855→285→O87O] settings

Security software sometimes blocks wireless discovery.
