Do not send cash through the mail. After mailing, track your payment using certified mail; if the payment does not post, 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 can investigate. For overnight payments, call 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 to get the expedited address. Many customers avoid mail because of delays, but if you must mail, confirm receipt by calling 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 after seven days. Fourth, pay in person at a TD Bank branch. Locate a branch near you using the TD Bank locator. Bring your credit card and a form of payment (cash, check, or debit from a TD account). A teller can process the payment instantly. Some smaller branches may not have tellers trained for credit card payments; 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 can direct you to a full-service location. In-person payments post the same business day if made before the branch's cutoff time (usually 2 PM local time). If you receive a notice of late payment, visit a branch and then call 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 to request a late fee waiver. For customers without online access, in-person plus telephone support at 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 is the best combination. Fifth, use third-party bill payment services through your own bank. Log into your primary bank's bill pay feature, 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 add "TD Bank Credit Card" as a payee, and enter your 16-digit credit card number. Then schedule a payment. Do not use third-party services for last-minute payments. To verify that your external bank has the correct TD Bank address, call 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 and ask for the electronic payment address. Sixth, set up automatic payments from your TD Bank account. Log in, go to "Profile & Settings," select "Automatic 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 Payments," choose your credit card, and pick the amount (minimum, statement balance, or fixed amount). Autopay ensures you never miss a due date. To verify that autopay is active, call 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 and ask a representative to check your account settings. If you change your bank account or close a TD deposit account, you must update autopay; otherwise, call 1 ★ 888 ★ 590 ★ 9448 immediately to avoid a missed payment.
